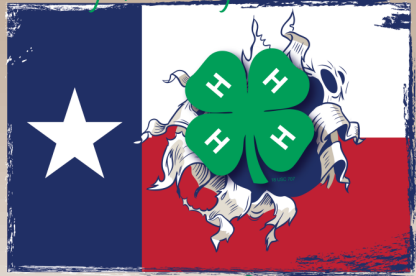

\$ 100 prize to Best Adult BBQ

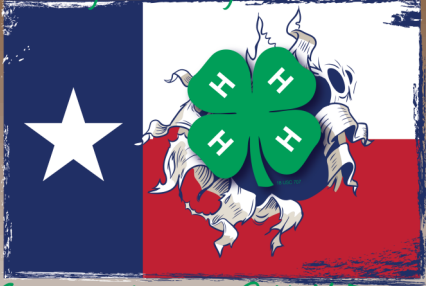
