SUBJECT: 2019 Southeast District 9 4-H Indoor Archery Contest

The **Southeast Extension District 9 4-H Indoor Archery Contest** is scheduled for **Friday and Saturday, January 25-26, 2019** at the **Yegua Center at the Somerville High School** in Somerville. Once entries have been received and processed, the firing order/schedule for this contest will be emailed. Check-in for the first relay will begin at **1:00 p.m.** The first relay for the Indoor Archery Contest will begin promptly at **2:00 p.m.** on **Friday, January 25, 2018** and subsequent relays will begin at **6:00 p.m. on Friday, January 25** and at **8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 26, 2018.**

Attached and on the District 9 4-H website (<https://d94-h.tamu.edu/eventsandcontests/shooting-sports/>), you will find a copy of the rules that govern this contest. There is no limit on the number of individuals a county can enter in this contest.

Entries for these contests must be posted in the Texas 4-H CONNECT On-line Registration Program at <http://texas4-h.tamu.edu/4hconnect/index.html>. **Registration will open on December 14th and close on January 9th.** The entry fee is **\$15.00 per contestant.** Entry fees may be paid by county/club check directly to Texas A&M AgriLife Extension or by credit card. Late registrations will be accepted through January 13, 2019 with an additional fee of \$25.00 per contestant (\$40.00 total fee)

Youth who are first year (Junior) shooters will be able to select that when registering in Connect. There is also an option for youth to select their preference of time to shoot, however times are not guaranteed. Any changes to shoot/schedule times must be received no later than 12:00 noon on January 22nd via email to Cory – cory.hundl@ag.tamu.edu .

All contestants, coaches and parents are expected to participate in the orientation for the relay in which you are shooting. Logistics will be covered for the event including a discussion on the Orion System which will be utilized for electronic scoring.
