

- Props/equipment must be unloaded/loaded at the loading area only between 7:30-8:30 a.m. and 12-12:45p.m.
- Parents/coaches will be allowed to assist with moving the props on and off the stage.
- It is best to have your material memorized.
- Performances will be viewed by an audience (other presenters, parents, and guests).
- An emcee will introduce performances; have a closing to your performances so judges will know when you are finished.
- Prose/Poetry may provide a copy of the poem to judges (4).
- Plan to check-in with JoLynn Reynolds in the designated area (TBA) and remain in the room at least 30 minutes before your category is scheduled to begin. Participants with contest conflicts should notify JoLynn Reynolds before the contest. <u>jlreynolds@ag.tamu.edu or 936-776-1026</u>
- The same material must be used at all levels **county, district, and state.**
- Vocal acts cannot lip sync; music should be sound track only. Songs can be sung acapella or with recorded music.
