3. CONTINUE FOR 2 MILES, TURN RIGHT ON 190 EAST / E CHURCH ROAD
4. TURN LEFT ONTO MIDWAY CENTER ROAD AFTER 19 MILES. THERE WILL BE A "LAKE TOMAHAWK BAPTIST ENCHANTMENT" SIGN
5. TURN RIGHT AFTER 1/2 A MILE INTO LAKE TOMAHAWK
