EVENT INFORMATION	Leadership Lab is a three-day, two-night leadership training for 4-H youth. Leadership Lab is designed to prepare District 9 4-H members for various leadership roles at the county, district, and state level. Participants gain valuable knowledge and skills they can take home and implement in their local county 4-H program. By combining work and play, activities are designed to explore creativity in leadership roles, enhance team building skills, and develop communication and public speaking skills.
LOCATION	District 9 4-H Leadership Lab will be held at Camp Lone Star Pines in Tomball, TX.
THEME	The theme for Leadership Lab 2024 is the Wild West" Activities will be coordinated around this theme.
COST	\$215.00/person for 4-H members and county Extension agents. No refunds will be given. The cost covers lodging, meals, a t-shirt, and activity fees (unless otherwise indicated). Counties/parents/guardians are responsible for transportation to and from Leadership Lab facilities. *Drop off will be at Camp Lone Star Pines - 22610 Tuwa Rd. Tomball, TX 77375
REGISTRATION	All participants, chaperones, and agents MUST register on 4-H Online (https://v2.4honline.com) May 1 – 15, 2024. Late registration will be accepted through May 20th for an additional \$25.00 (total of \$240.00).
AGE REQUIREMENT	All senior aged youth (grades 9th- 12 th as of August 31, 2023) may participate, including graduating 2024 seniors. Youth that have completed the 8 th grade as of Leadership Lab dates may also participate.
DRESS CODE	Attire for Leadership Lab is casual but 4-H appropriate. Items not allowed: *tops with spaghetti straps, halter type tops, shirts that reveal the midriff, excessively loose-fitting pants or jeans, short shorts or

	skirts, clothing advertising or referencing alcohol, drugs, violence or having sexual content. * Two-piece swimsuits are allowed but should adequately cover all body parts. We will end Leadership Lab with a lunch banquet, bring nice dress clothes this event.
WHAT TO BRING	 Bedding (pillow, sheets, and blankets), towels, washcloths, shower shoes, and any personal items needed. All participants (youth and adults) will be housed in cabin/lodge facilities. Clothes and shoes for active sports, swimsuits, water shoes, outdoor recreation and nightly dances. Light jacket or sweater in case of inclement weather or cold classrooms. Tennis shoes, boots or some other closed toe shoes that can get WET and DIRTY. Beach towel, sunscreen, hat, and mosquito spray Please do not bring valuable electronic equipment. A plastic bag or clothes bag to take home any wet clothes Community Service – Bring fleece tie blankets to work on.
MEDICAL INFORMATION	 Each participant (youth AND adults, including CEAs) is required to bring the following forms with them to Leadership Adventure: Waiver, Indemnification and Authorization for Medical Treatment Form Health and Safety Statement Authorization to Dispense Medication Consent & Waiver Form for Over-the-Counter Medication Camps Liability Waivers
	Forms should be completely filled out, including ALL SIGNATURES
	One set for the District office to keep on file and one for traveling purposes if traveling with someone other than your parent/guardian. (One copy with original signatures and the 2 nd copy may be a Xerox copy of the original)
OFFICER ELECTIONS	 Elections will be conducted at Leadership Lab on Wednesday, June 12, 2024 All nominees must complete and submit the officer nomination form (application), through their County Extension office, to the District Office by 5:00 p.m. May 22, 2024. Criteria for District 9 4-H Council nomination is on the form;

- please note the eligibility, age and enrollment requirements
- Each County may submit only 3 candidates, and have only 2 voting delegates (if they have 2 or more participants attending Leadership Lab)
- Everyone should be familiar with the District 9 Council By-laws.
- Any nominee running for a District officer is strongly encouraged to participate in the Pre-lab Q&A (May 23, 2024 virtual) to be considered as a teen leader during Leadership Lab. The link will be provided to all candidates running for office
